Systems of Linear Equations:

Extra Proficient Almost Ways-to-go

Student can set up a system of linear equations in a neat way. Variables are lined up.

Students are familiar with both substitution and elimination and can explain the process to another student.

The student can do either process and sees them as “two sides of the same coin”. Usually you can perform either one.

Students will know that you usually need one equation for each unknown in order to solve for that unknown.

Students will be able to solve a system with 3 equations and 3 unknowns.

*The fewer calculation errors and/or procedural errors we see, the more to the **left** I then place the check mark.
